CHICAGO EXECUTIVE AIRPORT Vehicle Rules & Regulations

- All vehicle operators on the Airport shall comply fully with the Illinois revised Statutes Title 625 ILCS (as may be amended from time to time), Airport Rules and Regulations, and instructions issued by the Executive Director.
- Vehicle operators must have a valid State driver's license and evidence of insurance.
- All vehicles that go inside the fence must be individually registered with the Airport and must display their own unique vehicle permit for the current year. The vehicle should be in sound mechanical order: has adequate lights, horn, and brakes.
- Vehicle operations on the Airport in a careless, negligent, unsafe, or reckless manner are prohibited. Driving a vehicle in an unsafe manner may result in the loss of vehicle Airport access. The speed limit inside the fence is 5 mph.
- T-Hangar tenants should park their vehicles inside their hangars when they are flying.
- Tiedown tenants should park their vehicles in their tiedown spot when they are flying. They may also park in the grass area directly next to their aircraft if it does not affect the adjacent tiedown. Do not park in another tenant's tiedown spot.
- The Airport may tow, remove, or cause to be removed from the Airport any vehicle that is disabled, abandoned, creates a safety risk, and/or parked in violation of the Rules and Regulations at the vehicle operator's risk and expense and without liability for damage that may result from such removal.
- Vehicles without a current permit must be parked outside the fence. Vehicles shall not be abandoned on or around the Airport.
- All vehicle operators shall ensure the gate completely closes behind them when entering and exiting the airfield.
- Unless given permission from the Airport Executive Director or Airport Operations the permit allows for vehicle privileges in non-movement areas only.
- Any vehicle operator who operates a registered vehicle in a movement area must be airfield certified by the Airport and the vehicle must meet the Rules and Regulations requirements.
- A complete list of rules is found in Section 4 of the Rules and Regulations.
